


Concordia chimney used by nesting and migrating chimney swifts!

Chimney swifts are the tiny birds that twitter over La Crosse and look like flying cigars. Swifts are "aerial insectivores," which means they feed exclusively on the wing, spending their days flying overhead and scooping up and eating insects. They nest primarily in chimneys, although their original nesting homes were large standing dead trees. Swifts winter in the Amazon basin of South America, so large numbers of swifts migrate through La Crosse spring and fall.

Chimney swift populations are in decline, prompting bird enthusiasts across the state of Wisconsin to organize 'chimney swift counts' (https://www.wiswifts.org/). La Crosse participates in these counts. One breeding pair uses our chimney in spring and summer. But in the fall, swifts like to sleep together in large groups. On September 16, Pat and Bobbie Wilson counted a stunning 272 swifts entering the Concordia's chimney for the night! Across the city of La Crosse, 1,181 swifts were counted that night.

The Concordia's chimney is no longer in service as part of the building's heating system, but still serves an important role in bird conservation. Several large chimneys in La Crosse have recently been 'capped', preventing use by the swifts. It is important to conserve the remaining chimneys available to the swifts. The Concordia hosts more than dances and events; it's a sanctuary for birds too!
